Using "So do I / So am I / So can I"

We use **SO + auxiliary/modal + subject** to agree with affirmative sentences.

I love sushi. → So do I.

She is hungry. → So am I

Using "Neither do I / Neither am I / Neither can I"

We use **NEITHER + auxiliary/modal + subject** to agree with negative sentences.

I don't like onions. → Neither do I.

He can't cook. → Neither can I.
