

Embedded Questions II

Grammar reminder:

In embedded questions, use **statement word order** (subject + verb). Do NOT invert the verb.

Use **if / whether** for yes/no questions, and **the wh- word** for wh- questions.

Example: Where does he live? → **I don't know where he lives.**

Task: Use the phrase and the direct question to write an embedded question.

#	Phrase	Direct question	Your embedded question
1	Do you know ...	Where is the nearest pharmacy?	
2	I'm not sure ...	Is she coming to the party tonight?	
3	I wonder ...	What time does the last train leave?	
4	Can you tell me ...	How much does this jacket cost?	
5	I have no idea ...	Where did I put my keys?	
6	I don't know ...	Why did they cancel the concert?	
7	I wonder ...	Has she ever lived abroad?	
8	Do you know ...	How long have they been waiting?	
9	Can you tell me ...	What was the weather like in Prague last week?	
10	I'm not sure ...	Will the meeting be online or in person?	
11	I have no idea ...	What are they going to do about the noise?	
12	I don't know ...	Had he met her before the wedding?	
13	Can you tell me ...	How long will the repairs take?	
14	I wonder ...	Were they arguing when you arrived?	
15	I have no idea ...	Who will be running the project next year?
