

PRESENT SIMPLE – I / YOU / WE / THEY

 I / You / We / They + **play** (VFS) + object / complement

1 AFFIRMATIVE Example: I **play** football every day. 

 I / You / We / They + **don't** + **play** (VFS) + object / complement

2 NEGATIVE Example: I **don't** play basketball. 

 Do + I / You / We / they + **play** (VFS) + object / complement ?

3 QUESTIONS Example: **Do** you **play** tennis? 

 **4 SHORT ANSWERS**

Examples:

- Yes, I do.
- Yes, they do.
- No, I don't.
- No, they don't.

Yes! No!

PRESENT SIMPLE – HE / SHE / IT

 He / She / It + **plays** (VQC) + object / complement

1 AFFIRMATIVE Example: He **plays** football every day. 

 He / She / It + **doesn't** + **play** (VFS) + object / complement

2 NEGATIVE Example: He **doesn't** play basketball. 

 Does + He / She / It + **play** (VFS) + object / complement ?

3 QUESTIONS Example: **Does** she **play** tennis? 

 **4 SHORT ANSWERS**

Examples:

- Yes, he does.
- Yes, she does.
- No, he doesn't.
- No, she doesn't.

FUTURE SIMPLE WITH WILL

STRUCTURE IN ENGLISH



1 AFFIRMATIVE

Structure: Subject + will (VTOBE) + verb (VFS) + complement

Example: I will play football tomorrow.

2 NEGATIVE

Structure: Subject + will not (won't) (VTOBE) + verb (VFS) + complement

Example: She won't visit her grandma next weekend.

3 QUESTIONS ?

Structure: Will (VTOBE) + Subject + verb (VFS) + complement ?

Example: Will you help me with my homework?

4 SHORT ANSWERS

Yes, Subject + will (VTOBE) + complement. Yes!

No, Subject + will not (won't) (VTOBE) + complement. No!

Examples:

- Yes, I will.
- Yes, you will.
- Yes, he will.
- Yes, she will.
- Yes, it will.
- Yes, we will.
- Yes, they will.
- No, I won't.
- No, you won't.
- No, he won't.
- No, she won't.
- No, it won't.
- No, we won't.
- No, they won't.

STRUCTURE IN ENGLISH



1 AFFIRMATIVE

Structure: Subject + am / is / are (VTOBE) + going to + verb (VFS) + complement

Example: I am going to play football tomorrow.

Example:

She **isn't** going to watch TV tonight.

Examples:

- Yes, I am.
- Yes, you are.
- Yes, he / she / it is.
- Yes, we are.
- Yes, they are.

- No, I am not.
- No, you aren't.
- No, he / she / it isn't.
- No, we aren't.
- No, they aren't.



We use "going to" to talk about **plans, intentions** or **prediction based on evidence** in the future.



- I (take) some photos at the weekend.
- They (order) a pizza for dinner.
- We (not play) football tomorrow.
- Paul (get) a summer job.
- (you / phone) me tonight?
- Molly (not buy) a new skirt for the party.
- (Greg / start) university next year?
- I (study) tonight.
