Negative: I won't (will not) play football on Saturday.

Question: Will you play football? (Yes, I will./No, I won't.)

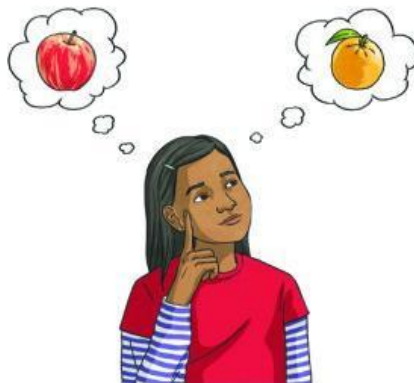
