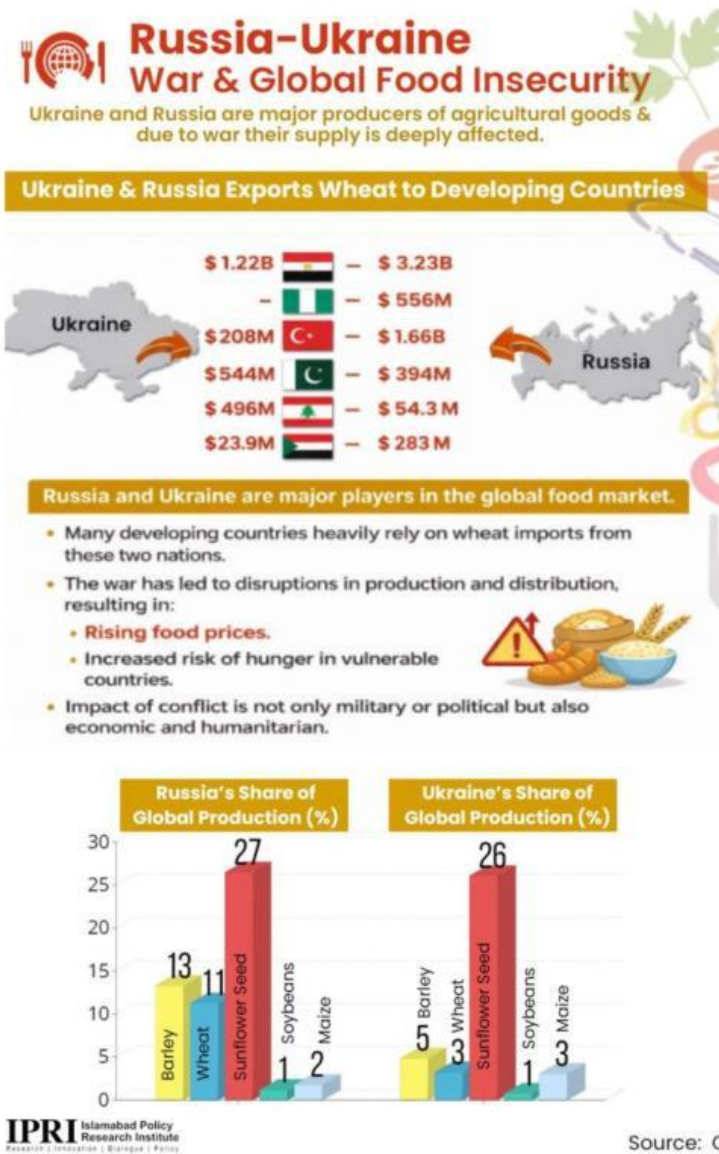

Wakatobi has potential marine natural resources of high value with amazing underwater panorama. In general, the marine waters have configurations ranging from flat to sloping towards the sea, and there are some areas of steeping waters. The depth of the water are varies, the deepest part reaches 1,044 meters with bottom waters mostly sandy and rocky.

The underwater biodiversity of Wakatobi is claimed to be higher than that of the Caribbean

and Egypt, currently known as the world's top diving centers. Around 90 percent of the globe's 850 coral species or 750 species found in Wakatobi.

There are also leaf corals, presenting attractive formations at a depth of 12 meters. Small fish such as cardinal and damsel fish are swimming around them, while hundreds of yellow back fusiliers are moving in a group near the surface. 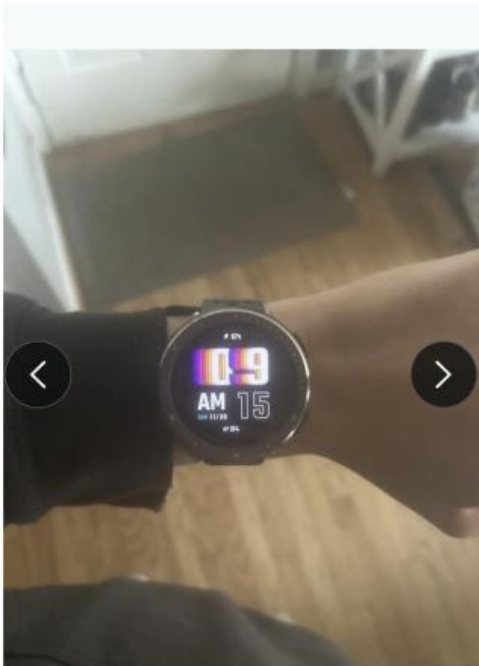
