It's a way to practice, build confidence, and get feedback. Some famous artists like Ed Sheeran and Tracy Chapman started their careers as buskers, gaining experience before becoming stars.

However, street performing also has challenges. In some places, a license or permission is required, and without it, performers may be fined or removed. Businesses sometimes complain about noise or crowds. Weather, long hours, and unfriendly people can also be difficult. Still, many buskers continue because they are passionate about their art and love making people smile. In conclusion, street performers show us that creativity can be found anywhere.
