Learn how and when to use **SOME** and **ANY**. ♥

1. LEÇON (en français)

SOME

SOME s'utilise dans les phrases affirmatives (positives).

On l'utilise pour parler d'une quantité indéterminée.

Exemples :

- I have **some** water. (J'ai de l'eau.)
- There are **some** books on the table. (Il y a des livres sur la table.)



★ **SOME** = dans les phrases affirmatives (+).

ANY

ANY s'utilise dans les phrases négatives et interrogatives.

On l'utilise aussi dans les phrases conditionnelles et les demandes.

Exemples :

- I don't have **any** money. (Je n'ai pas d'argent.)
- Do you have **any** brothers? (As-tu des frères ?)



♥ **ANY** = dans les phrases négatives (-) et interrogatives (?).

RAPPEL !

- **SOME** = affirmatif (+)
- **ANY** = négatif (-) et interrogatif (?)
- On peut aussi utiliser **ANY** dans les phrases conditionnelles :
If you need any help, call me.
(Si tu as besoin d'aide, appelle-moi.)

- **SOME** s'utilise dans les offres et les suggestions :
Would you like some tea?
(Tu veux du thé ?)
