(A) Erosion is a natural process that means wearing down. It happens when water or wind moves dirt and rocks. Erosion shapes the Earth. You can see the effects of erosion in river valleys. The water in the river gradually forms a valley by moving small rocks, sand, and dirt. (B) Erosion happens naturally, but sometimes humans speed up erosion by poor farming and building practices.
