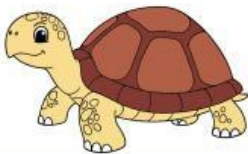

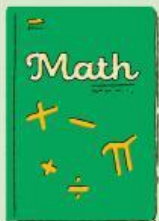
Unfortunately, that stopped Maria from practicing for a little while.
