

# PRESENT SIMPLE

Hoe zat het ook alweer??? De **shit-rule!!!**

He / She / It (=shit) krijgt bij de Present Simple een **S** of een **ES** achter het werkwoord:

I work hard → She works hard

You watch TV → He watches TV (+ES na een "s"-klank)

We drive a new car → Susan drives a new car (Susan=she, dus krijgt ook +s)

Alleen het werkwoord "to be" (zijn) is helemaal anders, dus dat rijtje moet je uit je hoofd kennen! (am/are/is)
