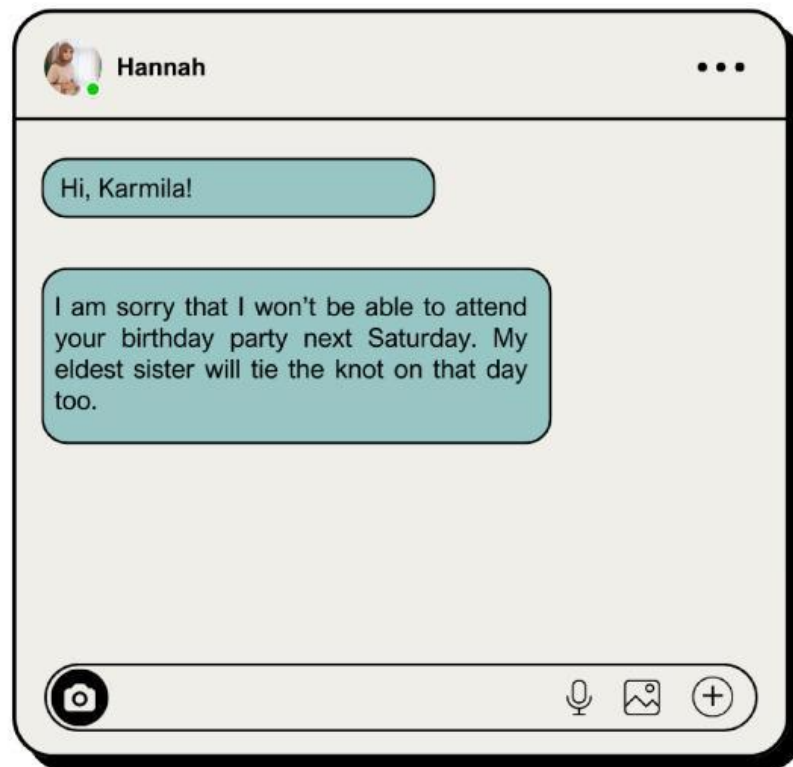

This city is distinguished by a collection of charming, red colonial Dutch buildings built between 1660 and 1700. To catch a panoramic view of the historical city from the top, tourists can hop aboard a glass cabin and ride to the top of Menara Taming Sari, where a revolving observatory soars 110 meters above ground.</p>
