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Lily loved painting. Every afternoon, she went to the park with her sketchbook to draw flowers, birds, and trees. She dreamed of showing her art in a gallery one day.

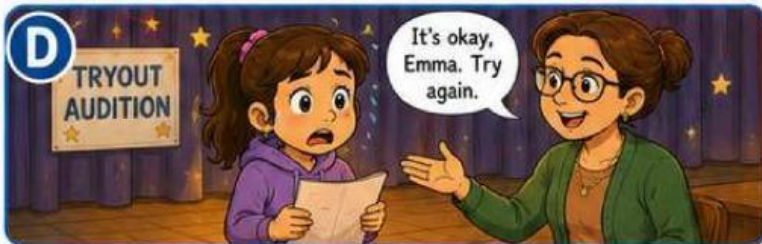
