RECOUNT TEXT

Celebrating Independence Day

A. Capaian Pembelajaran

Pada akhir Fase D, peserta didik mampu menganalisis struktur dan ciri kebahasaan teks recount tentang perayaan Hari Kemerdekaan, mengevaluasi penggunaan simple past tense dalam teks, serta menciptakan teks recount pendek tentang pengalaman pribadi mengikuti lomba 17 Agustus dengan struktur orientation, events, dan reorientation yang tepat menggunakan kata kerja lampau dan time signals secara akurat.



B. Tujuan Pembelajaran

1. Peserta didik mampu mengidentifikasi informasi spesifik tentang pengalaman pribadi saat merayakan Hari Kemerdekaan.
2. Peserta didik mampu menyusun kejadian utama dari pengalaman pribadi ke dalam struktur teks recount yang tepat (orientation, events, re-orientation).
3. Peserta didik mampu menulis teks recount sederhana tentang pengalaman pribadi mengikuti lomba 17 Agustus dengan menggunakan simple past tense secara tepat.

C. Alur Tujuan Pembelajaran

Peserta didik membaca dan menemukan informasi dalam teks recount, lalu memahami struktur (orientation, events, reorientation) dan ciri kebahasaan (simple past tense dan time signals). Setelah itu, peserta didik membuat kalimat sederhana menggunakan simple past tense, dan akhirnya menulis teks recount pendek tentang pengalaman lomba 17 Agustus.



CELEBRATING INDEPENDENCE DAY

A. WHAT IS RECOUNT TEXT?

Recount text is a text that tells about past experiences or events. The purpose is to inform or entertain the reader.

Examples of past experiences:

- Joining an Independence Day competition
- Going on a vacation
- Your first time riding a bicycle

C. LANGUAGE FEATURES OF RECOUNT TEXT

1. Simple Past Tense (V2)

Recount text tells about past events, so it uses past tense verbs (V2).

2. Time Signal

Time signals help show the order of events. (Last.., First, After that, Finally..)

3. Action Verbs

Action verbs are words that show physical or mental actions. They tell us what people do.

B. STRUCTURE OF RECOUNT TEXT

1 Orientation

2 Events

3 Reorientation

Opening that gives information about who, where, and when

A series of events told in chronological order

First, all participants gathered at the school field. Then, the teacher gave us a spoon and a marble.

Closing that contains a comment or lesson learned

I learned that patience and focus are more important than speed.
