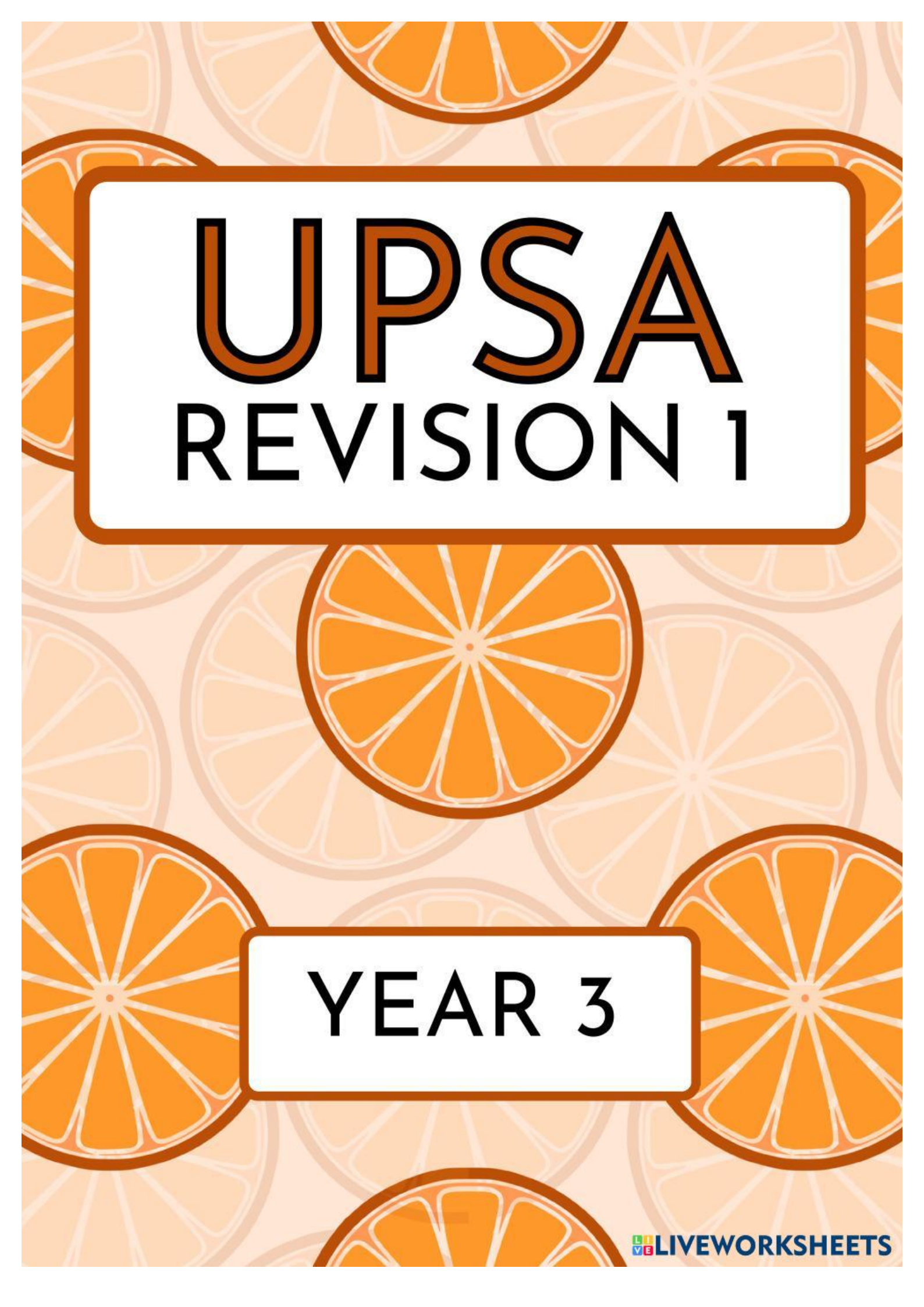

FOR MORE THAN ONE person
or thing (PLURAL) + I / YOU

- I have a new ball.
- You have a clean room.
- We have English today.
- They have a nice garden.



I, YOU, WE, THEY /
PLURAL NAMES
(e.g., Azlan & Siti)



HAVE



FOR ONE (SINGULAR)
PERSON OR THING
(not I or You)

- Hana has her book.
- The cat has a soft tail.
- Adam has a sharp pencil.

POSITIVE:

HAS / HAVE (YES!)

- You have the key.
- She has a pretty dress.

NEGATIVE:

HASN'T / HAVEN'T (NO!)

- ✗ We haven't had lunch. ✗
- ✗ He hasn't got a bicycle.



WATCH FOR THE DO/DOES SWAP!



- ✗ He hasn't know. ✗ vs. ✓ He doesn't have. ✓
- ✗ We haven't know. ✗ vs. ✓ We don't have. ✓
