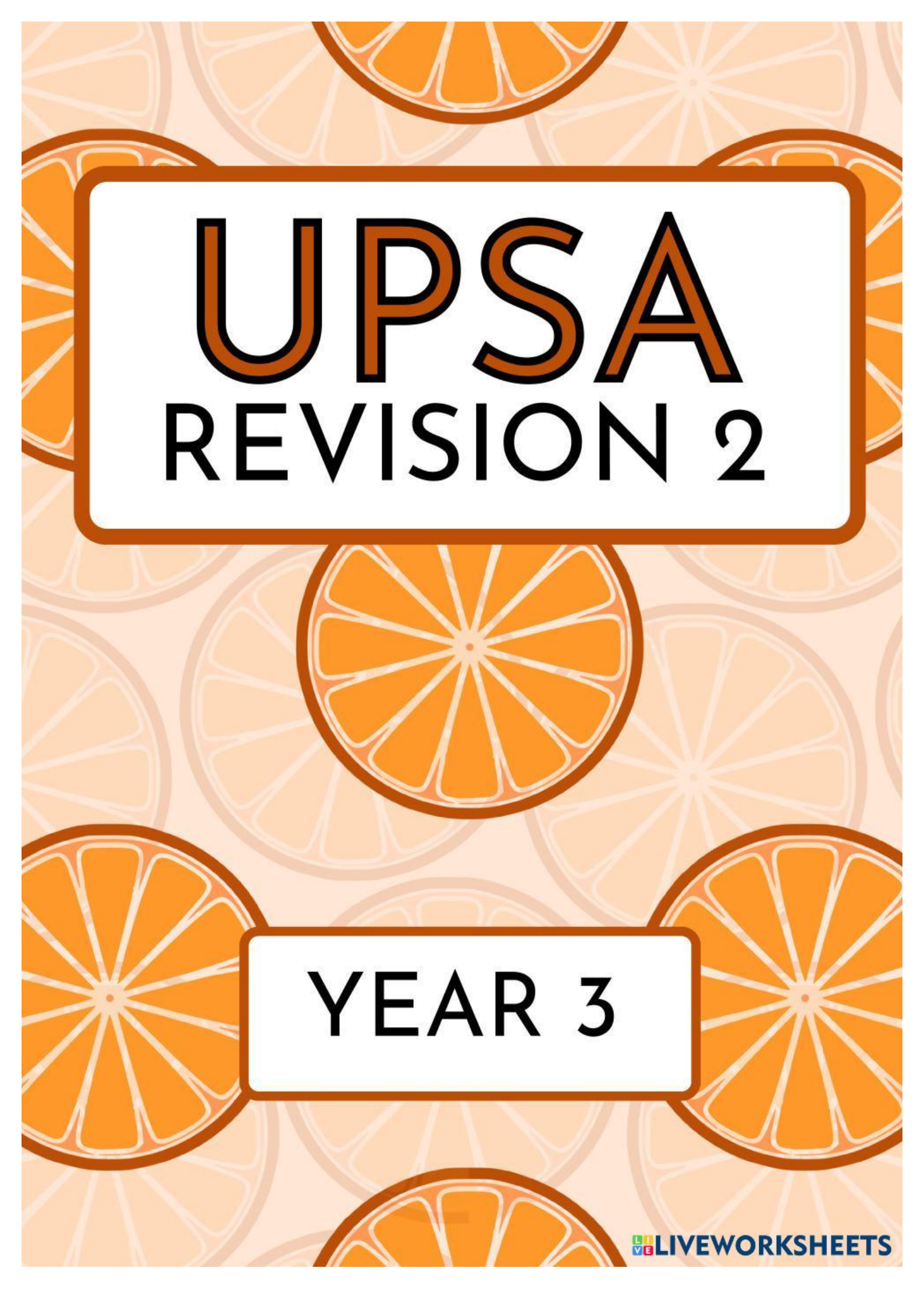

THE TWO-FINGER & ONE-FINGER RULE



FOR MORE THAN ONE person or thing (PLURAL) + I / YOU

→ I do my work.



→ You do your chores.



→ We do our best.



→ They do their exercise.



I, YOU, WE, THEY
PLURAL NAMES
(e.g., Aiman & Siti)



DO



FOR ONE (SINGULAR)
PERSON OR THING
(not I or You)

→ Hana does her art.



→ The cat does its sleeping.

→ Adam does his reading.



POSITIVE:

DO / DOES (YES!)

→ You do know the answer.



→ She does know how to swim.



NEGATIVE:

DON'T / DOESN'T (NO!)

✗ We don't go on Sundays. ✗

✗ He doesn't like spicy food. ✗
