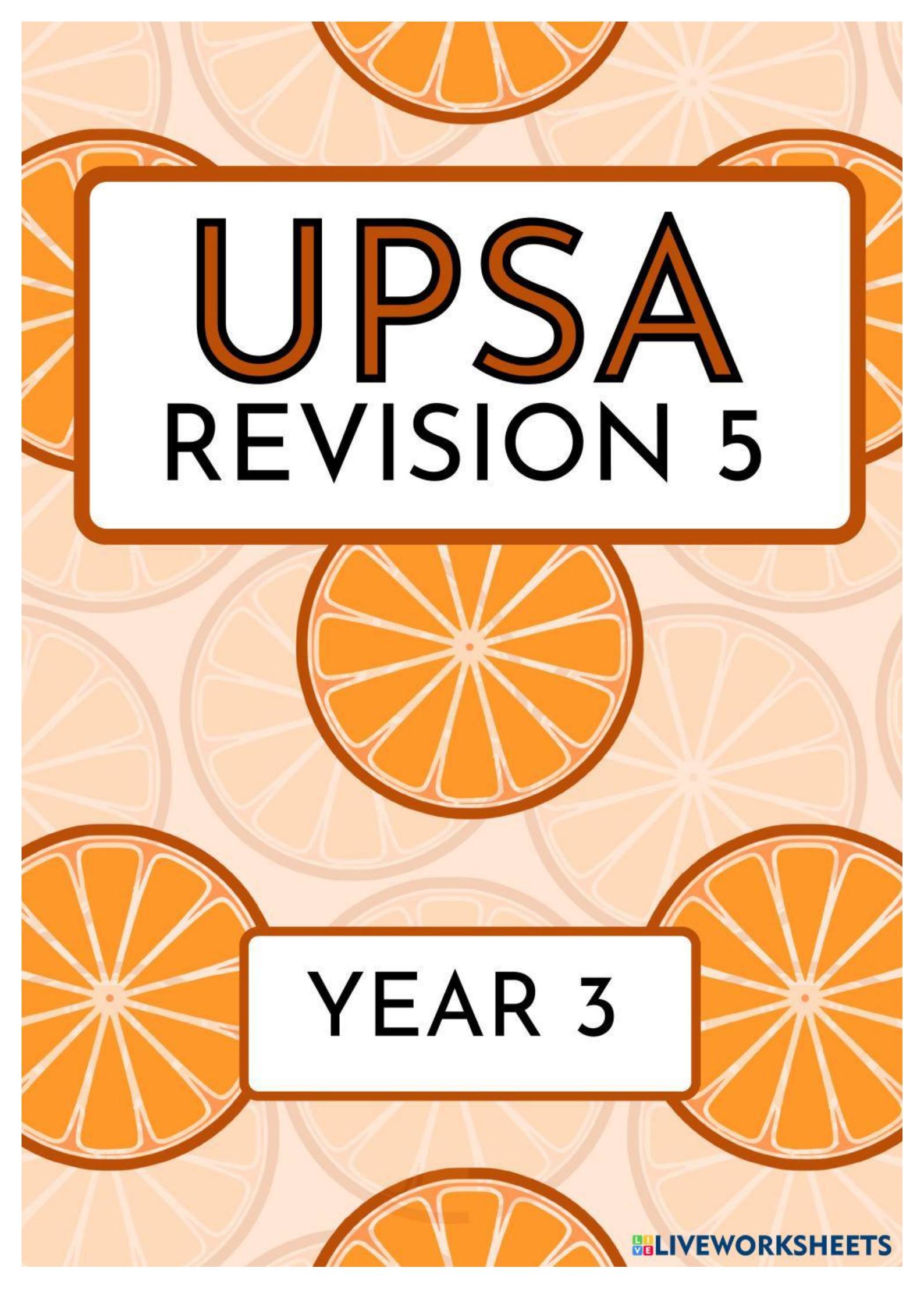

→ They are playing football.

→ The birds are flying.

→ The mangoes are sweet.

THE TWO-FINGER RULE!
If it's more than ONE / **AREN'T**.

The cars
Plural names
(e.g., Adam & Siti)

ARE / AREN'T

GREEN LIGHT: ARE (YES!)

→ The mangoes are sweet.

→ You are the winner.

→ We are ready.

RED LIGHT: AREN'T (NO!)

✗ The cars aren't here.

✗ They aren't ready. ✗

✗ You aren't first.

LOOK OUT FOR THE I / YOU EXCEPTION!



YOU → You are smart.

YOU → You aren't a monster. ✗

I → I am a student.

I → I am not a teacher. ✗

Even though there's only 1 of YOU, use **ARE / AREN'T**!
and for I, always use **AM / AM NOT**.
