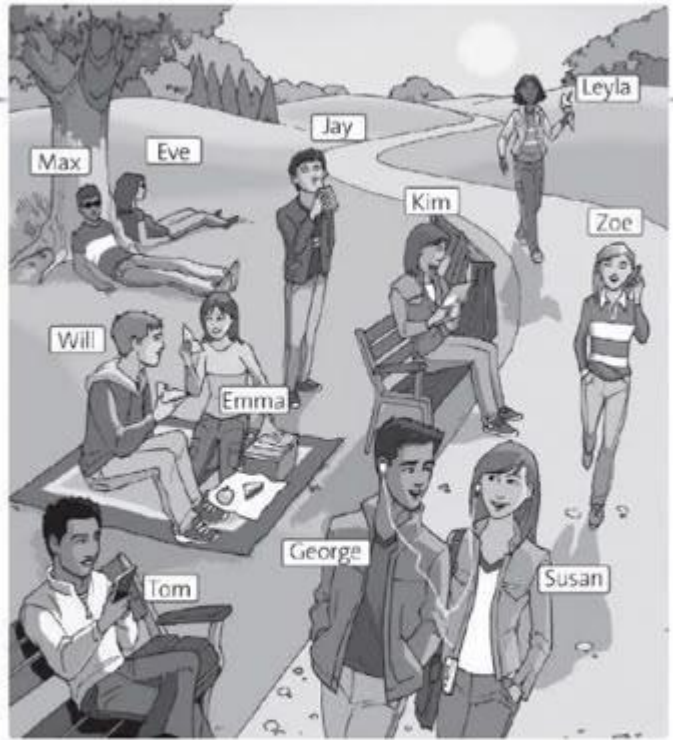

Past Continuous Affirmative

we use "be"(past) + "ing" verbs

I was running fast.
She was doing homework.
He was watching TV.
It was snowing.
They were exercising.
We were playing soccer.
You were laughing.

Past Continuous Negative

we use "be" (past) + "not" + "ing" verbs

I was not running fast.
She was not doing homework.
He was not watching TV.
It was not snowing.
They were not exercising.
We were not playing soccer.
You were not laughing.

Past Continuous Question

We use "be" (past) followed by "Pronoun or subject"

Was I running fast?
Was she doing homework?
Was he watching TV?
Was it snowing?
Were they exercising?
Were we playing soccer?
Were you laughing?
