Panjat Pinang, An Indonesian Traditional Game

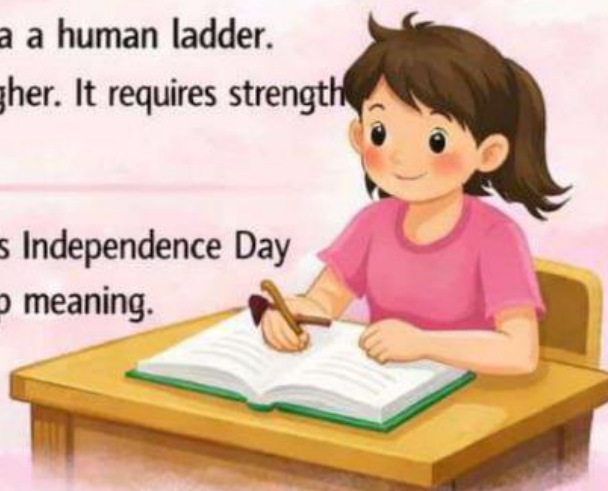
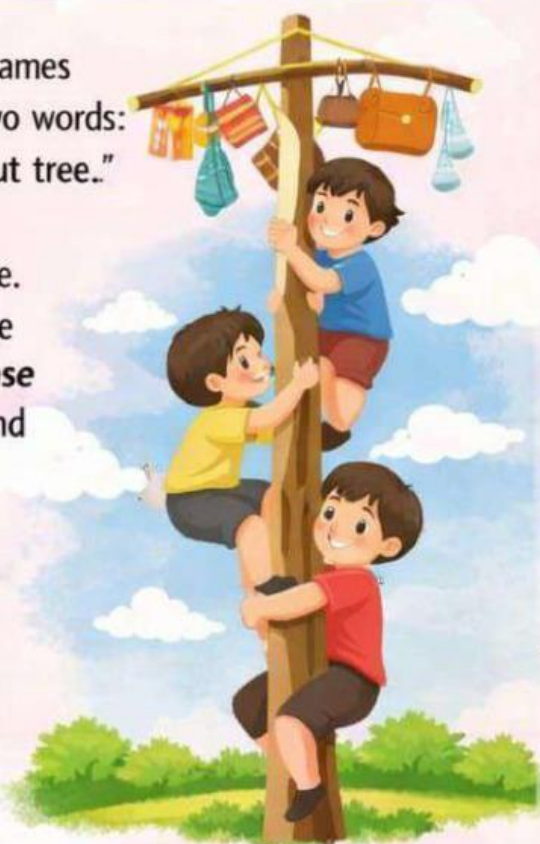
Panjat Pinang is one of the most exciting traditional games in Indonesia. The name **Panjat Pinang** comes from two words: **panjat** means “**to climb**” and **pinang** mean ‘areca nut tree.’

The game uses a very tall pole made from an areca tree. The pole is about 8 to 10 meters high. The most unique part is that the entire pole is covered with thick **grease** or used **oil**. This makes the pole extremely slippery and hard to climb.

At the top of the pole, there are many colorful prizes. The prizes are usually daily needs like rice, sugar, cooking oil, clothes, and even a bicycle. All the prizes are tied together at the top.

To play this game, people must work in a team. One person cannot climb the greasy pole alone. The team members help each other by creating a human ladder. They stand on each other's shoulders to reach higher. It requires strength, balance, strategy, and great teamwork.

Panjat Pinang is always played during Indonesia's Independence Day celebrations on August 17th. The game has a deep meaning.
