**Jobs in the Future**

Some web articles about jobs talk a lot nowadays about artificial intelligence (AI). You might think that AI will soon replace people in all high-paid jobs like lawyers, surgeons or company directors. AI certainly brings a whole new range of IT skills to the world of work. For example, data analysis can find the reason for sales rising or falling or the illness which a person is probably suffering from. However, it is possible that AI will become a valuable tool for people with top jobs, not replace them, because there are still limits to the power of AI.

Take a lawyer, for example. While an AI system may have access to every law and similar case in history, it cannot, at present, talk to a person in court and decide, for example, how honest the person is.

In the case of a surgeon, she may benefit from an AI system's complete knowledge of the way the human body works. But, at the moment, AI cannot use medical instruments in the way that a surgeon needs to be able to.

A company director can use an AI system to find out why something is happening to sales of a product, but the system does not have the ability to think of a solution.

Of course, all of these issues are about AI right now. In the future, it may be possible, for example, to add the ability to carry out complicated operations to an AI system for surgeons.
