

**CURRENT CHANGES AND DEVELOPING SITUATIONS****A. QUICK GRAMMAR REMINDER****1. Present Continuous for changes and developing situations.**

Ta dùng Present Continuous khi nói về một sự thay đổi, xu hướng, hoặc quá trình phát triển đang diễn ra trong giai đoạn hiện tại.

Nó không nhất thiết xảy ra ngay đúng lúc nói, nhưng đang thay đổi quanh thời điểm hiện tại.

Examples:

- The cost of living is rising. → Chi phí sinh hoạt đang tăng lên.
- More and more students are using AI tools for homework. → Ngày càng nhiều học sinh đang dùng công cụ AI để làm bài tập.
- His English is improving quickly. → Tiếng Anh của cậu ấy đang tiến bộ nhanh.
- The city is becoming more crowded. → Thành phố đang trở nên đông đúc hơn.
- Young people are spending more time online. → Người trẻ đang dành nhiều thời gian hơn trên mạng.

**2. Common verbs for changes and developments**

Một số động từ thường dùng với Present Continuous để nói về thay đổi / xu hướng:

increase = tăng lên	rise = tăng lên
grow = phát triển / tăng lên	fall = giảm xuống
decrease = giảm xuống	drop = giảm mạnh / giảm xuống
improve = cải thiện	get better = tốt lên
get worse = tệ đi	become = trở nên
change = thay đổi	develop = phát triển
spread = lan rộng	expand = mở rộng
disappear = biến mất dần	turn into = biến thành

**3. Useful patterns**

- More and more + plural noun + are + V-ing (ngày càng nhiều ...)

Example: More and more students are choosing online courses. → Ngày càng nhiều học sinh đang chọn các khóa học online.

- The number of + plural noun + is increasing / rising / falling.

Example: The number of students taking IELTS is increasing. → Số lượng học sinh thi IELTS đang tăng lên.

- Something is becoming + adjective.

Example: Education is becoming more technology-based. → Giáo dục đang trở nên phụ thuộc nhiều hơn vào công nghệ.

- Something is getting + comparative adjective.

Example: The exams are getting more competitive. → Các kỳ thi đang trở nên cạnh tranh hơn.

## B. NOTICE THE DIFFERENCE

### Pair 1

Students use AI tools for homework. → Đây là một nhận xét chung hoặc một thói quen.

More and more students are using AI tools for homework. → Đây là một xu hướng đang tăng lên hiện nay.

### Pair 2

The school offers online lessons. → Đây là dịch vụ thường xuyên của trường.

The school is offering more online lessons these days. → Trường đang tăng số lượng lớp online trong giai đoạn hiện tại.

### Pair 3

His English improves when he practises regularly. → Đây là một sự thật chung.

His English is improving because he is practising every day. → Tiếng Anh của cậu ấy đang tiến bộ trong giai đoạn hiện tại.

### Pair 4

Many teenagers spend time on social media. → Đây là một nhận xét chung.

Teenagers are spending more and more time on social media. → Đây là một xu hướng đang phát triển.

Pair 5

The city has a lot of traffic. → Đây là tình trạng chung.

The traffic in the city is getting worse. → Tình hình giao thông đang trở nên tệ hơn.
