

**PRESENT CONTINUOUS BEYOND “NOW”****A. QUICK GRAMMAR REMINDER**

Ở Bài trước, chúng ta đã học Present Continuous dùng cho tình huống tạm thời quanh hiện tại.

Trong Bài này, chúng ta học thêm 2 cách dùng nâng cao hơn của Present Continuous:

**1. Present Continuous for current changes and developing situations**

Ta dùng Present Continuous khi muốn nói rằng một tình huống đang thay đổi, phát triển, tăng lên, giảm xuống, hoặc chuyển biến trong giai đoạn hiện tại.

Cách dùng này rất hữu ích trong IELTS Writing Task 1 và Task 2.

Examples:

- The cost of living is rising. → Chi phí sinh hoạt đang tăng lên.
- More and more students are taking international English exams. → Ngày càng nhiều học sinh đang thi các chứng chỉ tiếng Anh quốc tế.
- His writing is improving because he practises every day. → Kỹ năng viết của cậu ấy đang cải thiện vì cậu ấy luyện tập mỗi ngày.
- Technology is changing the way students learn. → Công nghệ đang thay đổi cách học sinh học tập.

**2. Present Continuous with always / constantly / continually / forever**

Ta có thể dùng Present Continuous với always, constantly, continually, forever để nói về một hành động lặp đi lặp lại khiến người nói có cảm xúc mạnh.

Cảm xúc này thường là:

khó chịu/ phàn nàn/ bực mình/ chỉ trích nhẹ/ ngạc nhiên

hoặc đôi khi là khen ngợi / cảm phục

Examples:

- You are always interrupting me. → Bạn cứ ngắt lời tôi suốt. (Người nói đang phàn nàn.)
- He is constantly checking his phone during class. → Cậu ấy cứ liên tục kiểm tra điện thoại trong giờ học. (Người nói thấy khó chịu.)
- She is always helping other students. → Cô ấy lúc nào cũng giúp các bạn khác. (Người nói đang khen hoặc thể hiện sự cảm phục.)

### 3. Compare: Present Simple vs Present Continuous with always

- Present Simple with always thường nói về thói quen trung lập.

Example:

He always leaves his desk untidy. → Cậu ấy luôn để bàn bừa bộn. (Đây là một nhận xét chung.)

- Present Continuous with always thường thể hiện thái độ của người nói.

Example:

He is always leaving his desk untidy. → Cậu ấy cứ để bàn bừa bộn suốt. (Người nói đang phàn nàn rõ hơn.)

### B. NOTICE THE DIFFERENCE

Pair 1

Students use AI tools for homework. → Đây là một nhận xét chung hoặc một thói quen.

More and more students are using AI tools for homework. → Đây là một xu hướng đang tăng lên hiện nay.

Pair 2

The price of private education rises every year. → Đây là một nhận xét chung về xu hướng thường xuyên.

The price of private education is rising. → Giá đang tăng trong giai đoạn hiện tại.

Pair 3

He always checks his phone after class. → Đây là một thói quen bình thường.

He is constantly checking his phone during class. → Đây là hành động lặp lại gây khó chịu.

Pair 4

My sister always borrows my clothes. → Đây là một thói quen.

My sister is always borrowing my clothes without asking. → Người nói đang phàn nàn.

Pair 5

Our teacher always gives us useful feedback. → Đây là một thói quen tốt.

Our teacher is always giving us useful feedback. → Người nói nhấn mạnh sự biết ơn hoặc đánh giá tích cực.
