HAPPINESS

Feeling joy, satisfaction, and positive contentment. It makes you smile and laugh.

Keywords: Glad, Joyful, Cheerful



SADNESS

Feeling unhappy, low, or experiencing grief and sorrow. You might cry or want to be alone.

Keywords: Down, Blue, Unhappy



ANGER

A strong feeling of extreme displeasure, frustration, or hostility when things go wrong.

Keywords: Mad, Furious, Annoyed



FEAR

Feeling scared, anxious, or threatened by danger. Your heart beats fast and you want protection.

Keywords: Afraid, Scared, Terrified



SURPRISE

The feeling you get when something completely unexpected or astonishing happens.

Keywords: Amazed, Shocked, Astonished



DISGUST

A strong feeling of dislike, revolt, or disapproval toward something nasty, yucky, or unpleasant.

Keywords: Nasty, Awful, Repelled
