Remember:

Have to and must are used for obligations:

For example: She has to clean her room in the morning. / We have to wear a uniform for school

Visitors must show their tickets at the entrance.

Mustn't is used for prohibitions.

For example: We mustn't feed the animals at the zoo.

Don't/Doesn't have to shows something isn't necessary to do.

For example: He doesn't have to cook. (His mum does it)/ We don't have to go to school on Sundays.
