#### Buckingham Palace

There are two addresses in London that the whole world knows. One is 10 Downing Street, where the Prime Minister lives. The other is Buckingham Palace. This famous place, first built in 1703, is in the very centre of London. It is two places, **not** one. It is a family house, where children play and it is also the place where presidents, kings, and politicians go to meet the Queen. Buckingham palace is like a small town, with a police station, two post offices, a hospital, a bar, two sports clubs, a disco, a cinema, and a swimming pool.

Inside there are more than 800 decorated rooms, **including** 52 bedrooms and 78 bathrooms. Most of Buckingham Palace is private, but you can visit some of the beautiful State Rooms **on** public tours in the summer.

More than 600 people work in the palace including gardeners, cooks and cleaners. There are two people whose work is only to check the 300 clocks.

#### Top Things to see

In the Throne Room you can see the thrones that the Queen and Prince Philip use. Also, the Ballroom is the largest room in the Palace and the White Room has a secret door that takes you to the Queen's private apartments.

If you **got** to visit the palace you can't miss the "Changing the Guard" ceremony. It is at 11.30 am when new guards start working **inside** the Palace gates.
