- Use **am / is / are** to ask questions

Structure

(wh-word) Verb to be + subject + complement?

What is your name?

Where are you from?

Are you a student?

Short answers

Yes, I am. / No, I'm not.

Questions in Present Simple

Use **do / does** to ask questions

Structure

(wh-word) Do/Does + subject + base verb?

Do you work?

Where do you work?

Does your mother work?

Short answers

Yes, I do. / No, I don't.

Yes, she does. / No, she doesn't.
