DIALOGUE WITH FREQUENCY ADVERBS

★ 100% **ALWAYS**
(siempre)

★ 90% **USUALLY**
(usualmente)

★ 70% **OFTEN**
(a menudo)

★ 50% **SOMETIMES**
(a veces)

★ 10% **RARELY**
(rara vez)

★ 0% **NEVER**
(nunca)



Anna: Hi, Tom! What time do you get up?



Tom: Hi, Anna! I get up at 6:30 a.m. What about you?



Anna: I get up at 7:00 a.m.



Tom: Do you eat breakfast?



Anna: Yes, I do. I eat breakfast before school.



Tom: I eat breakfast at home.



Anna: Do you play soccer after school?



Tom: Yes! I play soccer with my friends.



Anna: Nice! I play sports, but I watch TV at night.



Tom: Haha! I watch TV before homework.



Anna: Good habit! Do you go to bed early?



Tom: Yes, I go to bed at 9:30 p.m.



Anna: I go to bed late on weekends.



Tom: See you tomorrow, Anna!



Anna: Bye, Tom! Have a nice day!

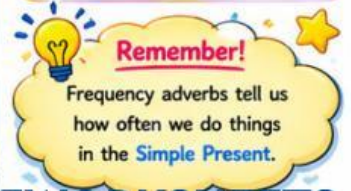
