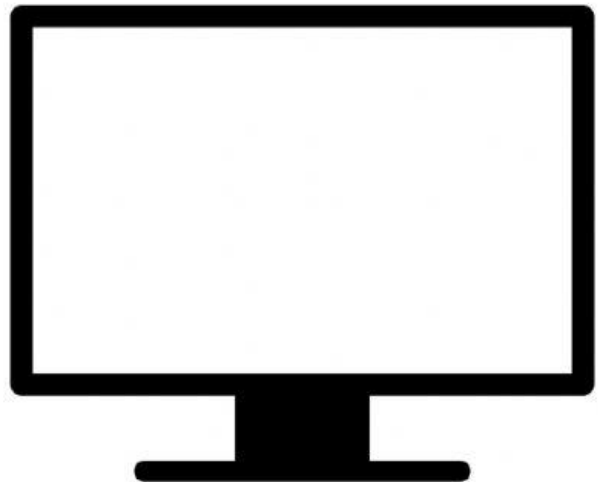


2) Have a look at the lyrics again and answer the following questions. Answer in full sentences and at least 3 sentences per questions.
