Auditory learners learn well through listening. They prefer discussing ideas, listening to lectures, and even reading aloud to understand new information. These students may find it useful to study with a partner or use recordings of lessons.

Kinesthetic learners learn best through movement and hands-on activities. They enjoy doing experiments, using real objects, or acting out situations to understand lessons. They may find it hard to sit still for a long time and prefer learning by doing.

Most students use a mix of learning styles, but knowing your dominant style can help you study better.
