There are a lot of trees and **a few** small stores. **There isn't a** movie theater, but **there is a** sports center where people **can** play soccer and basketball.

Visitors **can** walk **around** the neighborhood and enjoy the parks. They **should** visit the local market because it has fresh food and good prices. People **should** also be careful when crossing the street because **there is a lot of** traffic in the morning.

I like my neighborhood because it is clean, peaceful, and convenient.



1. There is / There are

We use **there is** for singular nouns and **there are** for plural nouns.

Singular	Plural
There is a park.	There are two stores.
Negative: There isn't a hospital.	Negative: There aren't any malls.
Question: Is there a bank?	Question: Are there any restaurants?

2. Prepositions of Place

Preposition	Example
next to	The park is next to the school.
between	The bakery is between the bank and the pharmacy.
in front of	The bus stop is in front of the library.
near	The restaurants are near the park.
behind	The parking lot is behind the supermarket.

3. Quantifiers

Quantifier	Use	Example
a lot of	many things	There are a lot of trees.
some	an unspecified quantity	There are some restaurants.
a few	a small number	There are a few small stores.

4. Should & Can

Can: Use for ability or possibility. (e.g., *Visitors can walk in the park.*)

Should: Use for recommendations. (e.g., *Tourists should visit the market.*)
