VERB "TO BE" (am, is, are)

AFFIRMATIVE (Yes!) ✓

- We use **am** / **is** / **are** in the affirmative.
- am** = I **is** = he, she, it **are** = we, you, they



NEGATIVE (No!) ✗

- We use **am not** / **is not** / **are not** in the negative.
- Short form:
I am not = I'm not He is not = He isn't They are not = They aren't

NEGATIVE (No!) ✗

I **am not** (I'm not)
He / She / It **is not** (He / She / It isn't)
We / You / They **are not** (We / You / They aren't)
