Guidelines (individual work)

1. Learning experiences

1. Create a Video Tutorial in Google Meet
2. Demonstrate how to create interactive worksheets in Liveworksheets.

3. To create your video, follow these steps:

1. You have to record a video tutorial lasting between 10 to 12 minutes explaining the use of Liveworksheets as an educator. You have to show how to create a short exam. It has to contain 2 parts. Each part must contain at least five items and their corresponding answers. In the video tutorial must be shown that the created test is well done.
2. You must create the tutorial using the Google Meet platform. You have to share your screen so that you can demonstrate how to use Liveworksheets. Your camera must always be on to see your face throughout the recording.
3. You should introduce yourself and say your name. **Wear formal clothes when recording your video.**
5. Keep in mind that you have to record your meeting to get the link.
6. Then, copy the link and share it in campus.ues.edu.sv in the space created to upload the first evaluated activity.

It is important to watch the video recorded by your teacher showing how to do it.

Evaluation

The following criteria will be considered:

Appearance (2).

- Student wears formal attire appropriate for a professional presentation.
- The student maintains an upright body posture and attentive facial expression

On-camera presence (2)

- Student's face is clearly visible throughout the video.
- Student maintains eye contact with the camera and shows confidence in presenting.

Content and Explanation (3)

- The tutorial clearly and thoroughly explains the steps for using Liveworksheets.
- Student demonstrates a solid knowledge of the topic and provides an exam that contains 2 parts. She/he shows how to create the exam.
- Information is presented in an organized and easy to follow manner.

Use of screen sharing (2)

- The student shares his/her screen effectively to show the practical steps.
- Demonstrations are clear and easy to see.
- The size of the shared screen is adequate and does not obstruct the student's visibility.

Duration of the video tutorial (1)

The video is 10 to 12 minutes long.
