#### The History of The Beatles

The four Beatles – John Lennon, Paul McCartney, George Harrison and Ringo Starr – were all born in Liverpool. John, Paul and George met each other at school and played together in a guitar-based rock band called The Quarrymen in 1959. They were in their late teens. Ringo joined the group later, in 1962, and played the drums.

On 9<sup>th</sup> November 1961, Brian Epstein, a record shop owner, saw The Beatles at the Cavern Club in Liverpool. They were playing rock songs. He talked with them and a month later he started to be their manager. Brian gave The Beatles a new image – the famous Beatle suits and haircut.

In 1963 the group had their first number 1 hit with their song *Please Please Me*. They gave their first USA concert on 11<sup>th</sup> February 1964. Girls were very passionate and cried when they went to The Beatles' concerts. They were extremely popular and everybody bought their records. By 1966 The Beatles had eight more Number 1 songs and five Number 1 albums.

In 1967 The Beatles made a very creative album: *Sergeant Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band*. Some years later, the four Beatles started to go different ways. In 1971 they finally split up. But the music of The Beatles didn't die. It had something special, and their music is still very popular today.
