Simple Form	Comparative form	Type of adjective
cheap safe big	cheaper safer bigger	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• One-syllable adjectives• One-syllable adjectives that end in -e• One-syllable adjectives that end in consonant vowel consonant
cozy recent quiet	cozier more recent quieter or more quiet	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Two-syllable adjectives that end in -y• other two-syllable adjectives• Some two-syllable adjectives have two forms
expensive	more expensive	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Adjectives with three or more syllables

- Note:**
- Use the Comparative form to compare two things.
 - If the second item is expressed, use "than" before it.
EXAMPLE: Brazil is **bigger than** Ecuador.
