Phrasal verbs	Definitions	Examples
turn up	to arrive at a place	They <i>turned up</i> at 9:00 p.m.
turn down	to say no to something	He <i>turned down</i> the invitation to the party.
turn it around	to change something from bad to good	He has low grades in math, but if he studies harder, he can <i>turn it around</i> .
turn out	to happen in a certain way or have a certain result	It <i>turned out</i> we hadn't done the laundry.
