This is the last day of the week. People usually stay at home, relax, or spend time with family.

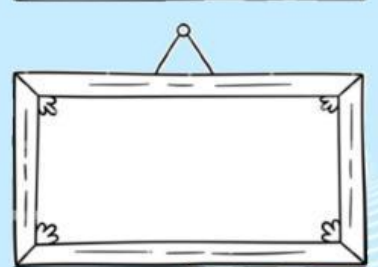
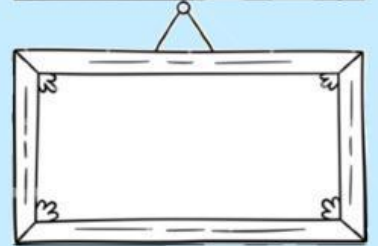
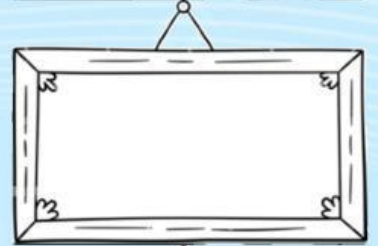
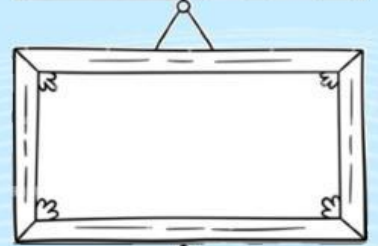
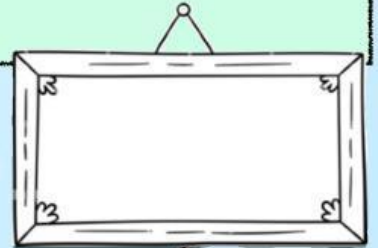
This is a normal school day. Students have lessons and study many subjects.
