A MARTA VIEIRA DA SILVA



FOOTBALL PLAYER

Marta was born in Brazil in 1986. She was a football player. She played in many World Cups (2003, 2007, 2011, 2015 and 2019). She grew up in a small town called Dois Riachos. She scored many goals and became one of the best players in history. She inspired millions of girls.

B SARINA WIEGMAN



COACH

Sarina Wiegman was born in the Netherlands in 1969. She played football when she was young. Later, she became a coach. She worked with different teams and in 2017 she became the coach of the Netherlands women's national team. In 2022, she won the UEFA Women's EURO with England. She is a great leader!

C STÉPHANIE FRAPPART



REFEREE

Stéphanie Frappart was born in France in 1983. She loved football from a young age. She became a referee and worked hard to reach the top. She was the first woman to referee a men's match in France's top division. She also refereed matches in the Women's World Cup and the UEFA Super Cup.

D ALEX MORGAN



FOOTBALL PLAYER

Alex Morgan was born in the United States in 1989. She started playing football when she was 14 years old. She played in the Women's World Cup in 2011 and 2015. She scored important goals and helped her team win. She is also a strong voice for equality in sports.

E SAM KERR



CAPTAIN & FORWARD

Sam Kerr was born in Australia in 1993. She started playing football when she was very young. She played in the Women's World Cup 2019 and 2023. She became the captain of the Australian national team. She is known for her speed, skills and leadership.
