

Work in the theatre

You set up and operate sound equipment in live theatre shows, which is used to make the voices of actors and singers louder and clearer and is also used for sound effects and music.

You design costumes and select accessories for use in theatre, film and television.

You make sure that people who appear on television, in film or the theatre have suitable make-up and hairstyles.

You help to set up scenery, props and furniture before performances. You also change things around in between scenes and during the interval.

You operate and maintain theatre lighting systems and electrical effects.

You oversee all aspects of a theatrical production, working closely with the director, actors and technicians.

You create or choose outdoor and indoor scenes for theatre, television and film productions. You read scripts then decide on the shape and size of sets, colour schemes and scenes.

You perform on film, television and radio. Your job is to bring to life the role you are playing as effectively as possible.
