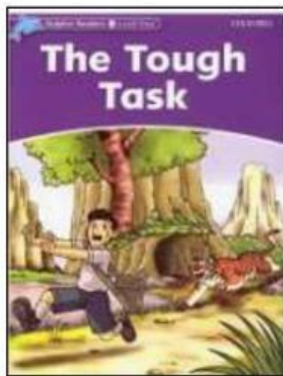


測驗前需知：
