Marta would have won the trophy if she _____ so quickly during the chess tournament.

6. We couldn't solve the maths problem in class, so the teacher had to explain it again.

Key word: **WORKED**

The teacher wouldn't have had to explain it again if we _____ the maths problem in class.

7. Liam didn't make his little sister feel happy after the match, so she cried all night.

Key word: **CHEERED**

Liam's little sister wouldn't have cried all night if he _____ after the match.

8. Sofia invented a silly excuse, and her parents didn't believe a single word.

Key word: **MADE**

Sofia's parents would have believed her if she _____ such a silly excuse.
