

# Procedure Text

## How to Make a Glass of Lemonade

A procedure text is a text that explains how to make or do something through a sequence of steps.



### Generic Structure

#### 1. Goal / Aim

It states the goal or what is going to be achieved.

#### 2. Materials

It lists the ingredients or things needed.

#### 3. Steps

It explains the steps or instructions in order to achieve the goal.



### Useful Tips

- Read all the steps before doing.
- Follow the steps in order.
- Use connecting words: *First, Next, Then, After that, Finally.*
- Be careful and patient!



### Example

## How to Make a Glass of Lemonade

**Goal:** To make a refreshing glass of lemonade.

#### Materials:

- 1 lemon
- 2 tablespoons of sugar
- 1 cup of water
- Ice cubes
- A glass
- A spoon

#### Steps:

- 1 First, cut the lemon in half.
- 2 Next, squeeze the lemon and pour the juice into a glass.
- 3 Then, add 2 tablespoons of sugar.
- 4 After that, pour 1 cup of water into the glass.
- 5 Stir well with a spoon until the sugar dissolves.
- 6 Finally, add some ice cubes. Your lemonade is ready to drink!
