

The History of the FIFA World Cup

The FIFA World Cup is the most important football tournament in the world. It is organized by **FIFA** every four years and brings together the best national teams from different countries.

The first World Cup started in 1930 in Uruguay. Only 13 teams participated in that tournament, and Uruguay became the first world champion after defeating Argentina in the final.



Over the years, the World Cup has become one of the biggest sporting events on the planet. Legendary countries such as Brazil, Germany, Argentina, and Italy have won the trophy and created unforgettable football moments.

The 2026 FIFA World Cup will be very special because it will be hosted by three countries for the first time in history: Mexico, Canada, and United States. In addition, 48 national teams will participate instead of 32.

Some of the countries that will participate in the 2026 edition are Mexico, Canada, the United States, Argentina, Brazil, England, France, Germany, Spain, Japan, Morocco, Egypt, Portugal, Uruguay, Colombia, and many others from all around the world.

Mexico will make history because it will become the first country to host the FIFA World Cup three times, after organizing the tournaments in 1970 and 1986. Football fans around the world are excited to enjoy this great celebration of sport, culture, and international friendship.

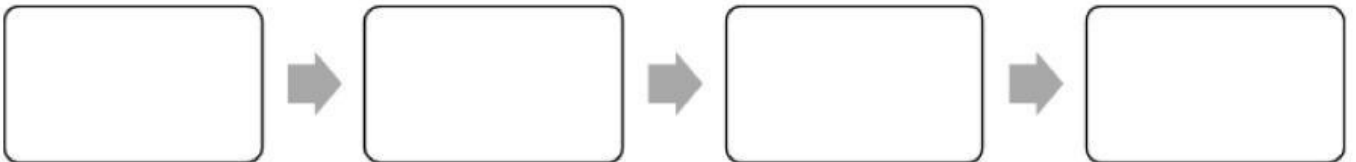
