

ACTION RESEARCH

Order the following sentences according to what you read in Chapter 3 by Costello. What are the necessary steps to develop an action research project?

- Meet with a supervisor or mentor** to discuss, refine, and agree on a strategy for carrying out the project.
- Plan the structure of the project and report**, including its rationale, methodology, and chapter organisation.
- Conduct a literature search and literature review** to determine whether the topic is viable and to establish connections between educational theory and practice.
- Ask questions and seek guidance whenever necessary**
- Choose an appropriate research topic** that is relevant to your educational context.
- Ensure continuity and coherence throughout the report** so that all sections contribute to the overall aims of the study.
- Develop a research proposal** that includes a tentative title, aims, research questions, etc.
- Undertake the research while maintaining regular contact with the supervisor**, submitting draft sections for feedback and making revisions when necessary.
- Attend research methodology seminars or training sessions** to develop knowledge about research methods, planning, writing, referencing, and presenting research.
