What time does it start?

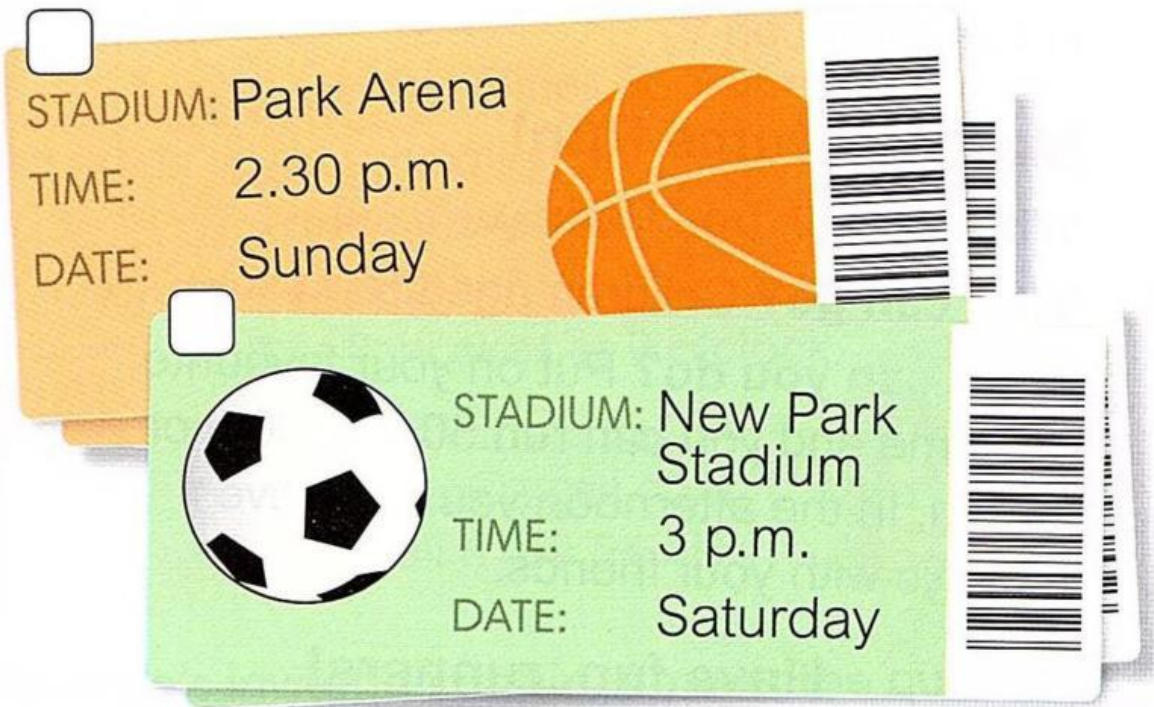
Where shall we meet?
