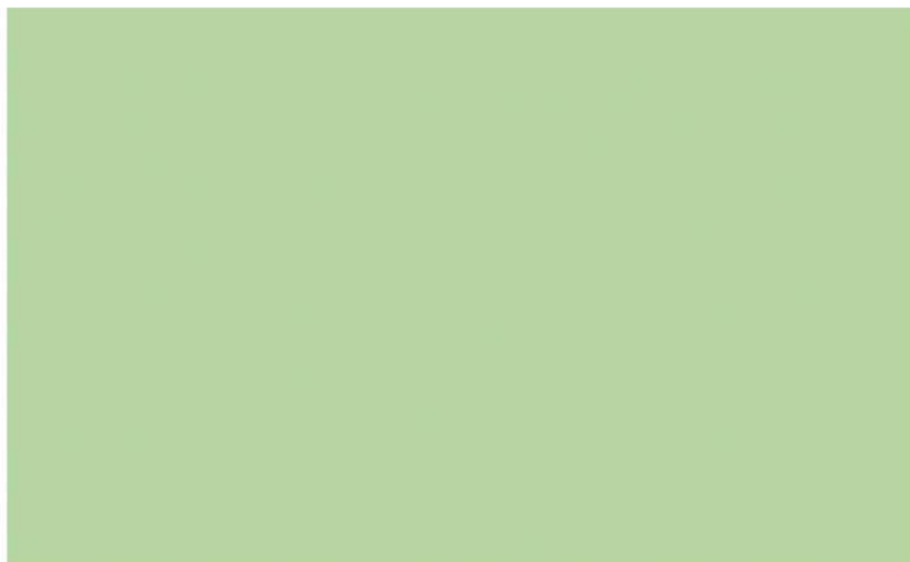




Brighton is also a great place for English teachers too. **Tom Veryzer** is a teacher in a well-known English institute in Brighton. Watch him talking about his work.
