Leopard seals' status in **6** is similar to that of other predators like tigers or lions. These mammals do not have external ear flaps and although their body shape is identifiable, they closely resemble **7** (both are spotted). Leopard seals have relatively good hearing but scientists today believe they use their **8** for navigation and hunting (by tracking **9** from their prey), rather than sonar.

Leopard seals can be seen as a solitude animal. They give birth on ice in a **10** made by the female, and only female leopard seals take care of the pups. While some seals use their hind legs to swim, leopard seals move underwater with their strong **11**
