Yayoi Kusama

Yayoi Kusama was born in Matsumoto, Japan in 1929, in a society where women had little or no voice, and even less so in the arts. In 1957, at the age of 28, she moved to New York to look for a new way to express her artistic mind and spirit.



At the age of 10, Yayoi Kusama met the world of color, sculpture, and modeling arts for the first time. Since then, she has been fascinated with it. She began creating works of art where fantasy and reality came together in places where nothing was what it seemed. These works intended to reflect the hallucinations that her own mind was producing. They were the solution Kusama thought of to counteract the effects of her mental disorder. She simply painted what she saw. She is part of the pop art movement. She also became a writer and film producer. Today she continues to present in art exhibitions around the world and in her home country of Japan.
