

## Superlative Adjectives (1)

Rule	How to change	Examples
1. Most Adjectives	Add <b>-est</b>	small → <u>smallest</u> long → <u>longest</u>
2. Ending in <u>Consonant + y</u>	Drop <b>-y</b> , add <b>-iest</b>	happy → <u>happiest</u> pretty → <u>prettiest</u>
3. Ending in <u>1 vowel + 1 consonant</u>	Double final consonant, add <b>-iest</b>	big → <u>biggest</u> hot → <u>hottest</u>
4. Irregular	No rules	good → <u>best</u> bad → <u>worst</u>
