Weather descriptions

1. It rains hard and fast in summer and is humid.
2. The weather here is less extreme.
3. Adelaide and Melbourne are in these regions.
4. It is scorching hot above 45 degrees C in summer, but can be below freezing in the wintertime.
5. These regions have 4 seasons.
6. These regions get 250 – 500 mm of rain per year.
7. These regions get the most rain in the wet season or the monsoon.
8. This region is drier.
