II. Adverbs of frequency

Adverb	Meaning
always	Luôn luôn
usually	Thường xuyên
sometimes	Thỉnh thoảng
never	Không bao giờ



III. Spelling (He/She/It)

- Add "s" to most verbs
Eg: Play- Plays
- Add "es" to verbs ending in: -s, -sh, -ch, -x, -o
Eg: watch- watches
- Change "y" to "i" and add "es"
Eg: cry- cries
- Irregular verbs: have- has
