Sentence Type	Structure	Examples
Affirmative (+)	S + V(s/es) + O I / You / We / They + V + O He / She / It + V(s/es) + O	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I play football every weekend. • She works in an office.
Negative (-)	S + do/does not + V (base form) + O I / You / We / They + V + O He / She / It + V(s/es) + O	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • They don't eat fast food. • He doesn't watch TV.
Yes/No Question (?)	Do/Does + S + V (base form) + O?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do you play football? • Does she live in Hanoi?
Short Answers	Yes, S + do/does. No, S + don't/doesn't.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Yes, I do. • No, I don't. • Yes, she does. • No, she doesn't.
Wh- Question (?)	Wh-Question + do/does + S + V (base form) + O?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Where does she work? • What do you do after school?
